Two Moors Nursery aims to provide a welcoming atmosphere for all. We offer an environment where children feel secure and happy, and are able to develop into confident individuals. Fully qualified, caring staff provide an inclusive curriculum tailored to children's individual needs, skills and interests.

Admissions and Fees

We accept new children at the beginning of each term, providing we have spaces available. If your child is on our waiting list we will offer them a place in the term following their third birthday, or you may prefer them to start at the beginning of a different term. If you are interested in a Nursery place for your child please contact the school and we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

Nursery session times:

The morning session runs from 9.00 - 12 noon

The afternoon session runs from 12.00 - 3.00

Full day from 9.00 - 3.00

Those children attending all day will have an additional 15 minutes for their lunch break at midday (which is not part of their allocated hours). You can choose whether to provide a packed lunch for your child or to buy your child a hot school dinner for £1.60 or a cold school lunch for £1.10.

You can also choose whether you would like your child to have half day sessions or whole days. We encourage children to have a mix of morning and afternoon sessions if possible.

If you would like your child to take more than their 15 hours free Early Years Entitlement, and we have spaces available, you are able to buy extra sessions for £4.50 per hour (£13.5 per session), payable termly in advance.

If you need to leave your child at school before 9.00 or collect them after 3.00, there is a Breakfast Club running from 7.45 - 8.45, and After School Club running from 3.00 - 6.00. This runs from the Nursery site and is available for

children from Nursery to Year 6. A handbook with information about session fees is available from the school office.

The Nursery works closely with the Reception classes and this means that at times during each term there will be opportunities for Nursery children and Reception children to work together. We provide plenty of opportunities for Nursery children to visit the Reception classes and meet the staff in the summer term, which allows for a smooth and happy transition into Reception for those children who join Two Moors Primary School for their statutory schooling.
