

TWO MOORS PRIMARY SCHOOL YEAR 6 INFORMATION



Dear Parents/Carers;

The start of the Day

Children are expected to congregate on the Upper Exe playground. The doors will be opened at 8.45am when the children will go to the cloakroom to hang up their coats and bags.

Registration is at 8.55am. If your child arrives after this, they need to go via the office and will be marked as late.

Year 6 Mornings

Having arrived quietly in class on time, the children complete an 'early morning activity' which enables them to settle down and 'warm up' for the morning lessons.

Mid-morning Fruit/Snack.

Children are NOT provided with fruit at break time in Key Stage 2 however snacks are available from the kitchen for £1.00 a week. These can be purchased through SCOPAY. Alternatively we would encourage you to provide your child with a healthy snack and a bottle of water **only** to keep them hydrated throughout the day as this will improve their concentration and health.

Lunchtime

Lunchtime is 12:15 to 1:15: During this time, children will enjoy their lunch in Exmoor Hall, and have the chance to take part in fun games and activities provided by the Two Moors mealtime assistants.

Phones

Mobile phones are **NOT** to be used in school, however if your child needs to use a phone for walking to and from school then they will need to take it to their class teacher for safe keeping. We kindly ask that smart watches are not worn to school and are left at home please.

P.E.

Scheduled PE sessions will be on **Wednesday** (outdoor) and **Fridays** (indoor) for Year 6 but this can be subject to change. PE kit consists of a white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers (separate from school shoes please.)

Please can clothes be **labelled clearly** as this makes finding and returning lost items so much easier.

Homework

Homework will be handed out every Friday and should be returned by the following Wednesday. Each week, children will complete a maths activity and a reading task in their homework booklet. Alongside this, we encourage 60 minutes of daily reading and regular times tables practice to help build confidence and fluency. All children are expected to complete their homework, but if anyone finds it tricky to manage at home, we offer support sessions to help them stay on track

Medication/Holiday/Absence Forms

Please inform the office before 9am if your child is going to be absent. If your child requires prescribed medicines to be administered at school, please complete a green medical form first, which can be found at the office and inform your child's teacher. Please note that we cannot administer non-prescribed medicines.

Educational Visits and Residential Visits

There will be a visit/activity/workshop each term. In the summer term, there will be a residential to the Isle of Wight. Letters and a payment schedule will be distributed in due course.

Certificates

During celebration assemblies on Fridays, children will receive certificates from Mr Dutton in recognition of their hard work and progress. If children have received any awards /certificates /medals outside of school and would like to share them with rest of Exmoor or their class they can bring them in.

Clubs

A variety of after-school clubs are available. Full details can be found on the school clubs timetable, which is accessible both at the school office and on the school website. An email is sent out each term with a link to book these online.
