I'm a firm believer that headline results from statutory testing do not show the true day to day learning, fun, excitement and vibrancy of everyday school life, nor do they show the progress that the children make to get to each point from their own unique starting points... but they are a part of what we do and they should be celebrated when possible...and as such – here's this year's amazing results from across the school's statutory assessments:

- Percentage of children achieving a 'Good Level of Development' (GLD) in Reception: 65%
- Percentage of children passing the Year 1 phonics check: 85%
- Percentage of children achieving full marks (25/25) in the Year 4 Multiplication Check: 36% (with an average score of 21.1/25)
- Percentage of children achieving the expected standard in the Year 6 reading test: 68%
- Average scaled score in reading: 103.6
- Percentage of children achieving the expected standard in Year 6 writing: 70%
- Percentage of children achieving the expected standard in the Year 6 maths test: 73%
- Average scaled score in maths: 102.9
- Percentage of children achieving an expected combined score in Year 6 reading, writing and maths: 55%
- Percentage of children achieving a higher combined score in Year 6 reading, writing and maths: 4%

Congratulations to everyone involved in these assessments – they are brilliant results, and everyone should be very proud.
