YEAR 4 INFORMATION



Dear Parents/Carers,

We're delighted to welcome you and your child to Year 4. Below is some helpful information about our routines and expectations to ensure everyone gets off to a great start.

The start of the Day

Children are expected to meet their teacher at the Year 4 classrooms. The doors will be opened at 8.40am and children will then go to the cloakroom to hang their coats/bags on their peg. Next children will take their packed lunch bag to the classroom to be stored in a safe place, also remembering their book bag.

Children are responsible for recording the title of their reading books in their reading records.

Registration is at 8.55am. If your child arrives after this, they need to go via the office and will be marked as late.

Year 4 Mornings

Having arrived in class, the morning session will start promptly with an early morning activity which enables the children to settle down and 'warm up' for the morning lesson.

Mid-morning Fruit/Snack.

Children are NOT provided with fruit at break time in Key Stage 2 however snacks are available from the kitchen for £1.00 a week. These can be purchased through SCOPAY. Alternatively, we would encourage you to provide your child with a healthy snack and a bottle of water **only** to keep them hydrated throughout the day as this will improve their concentration and health.

Lunchtime

This will take place from 12.15 to 1.15. Part of the time will be spent eating lunch in Exmoor hall and during the other time the children will be on the playground.

P.E.

Children are expected to arrive in school on their PE days wearing their PE kit, they will remain wearing their kit for the day. Scheduled PE sessions will be on a Monday and a Thursday but these can be subject to change, or indeed additional sessions may take place, in which case you will be informed.

Please label all belongings clearly as this makes finding and returning lost items so much easier.

Homework

Spellings and a homework grid will be given out on a half-termly basis. All children are expected to engage with their homework and maintain regular reading and times tables practice.

Medication/Holiday/Absence Forms

Please inform the office before 9am if your child is going to be absent. If your child requires prescribed medicines to be administered at school, please complete a green medical form first, which can be found at the office and inform your child's teacher. Please note that we cannot administer non-prescribed medicines. If your child uses an inhaler, please ensure these are handed to the class teacher with a complete medical form.

Certificates

In Friday's 'celebration assembly', children will receive their certificates from Mr. Dutton in recognition of their hard work and progress. If children have received any awards/certificates/medals etc. outside of school and would like to share them with rest of Key Stage 2 or with their class, they can bring them in to school.

Clubs

Activities/clubs are available after school and these are detailed in the school clubs' timetable available from the office and on the website. An email is sent out each term with a link to book these online.

Curriculum

In year 4 your children will be expected to learn and know the all of the times tables, up to and including the 12 times table. We will work on these regularly but any further learning at home will help your child to recall facts quickly.

We have reviewed our curriculum and have created a curriculum that meets the needs of all our pupils whilst ensuring it is interesting, exciting and relevant for our pupils. The End of the Day

Children will be escorted to the doors outside of their classrooms and will be encouraged to find their parent/carer independently. Your child's class teacher will wait outside their class to ensure all children find their parent/carer safely.

Children will be told to come straight back to the teacher if they cannot find their adult.

N.B. If your child is going home with a different adult please inform the office or your child's teacher ASAP.
