

TWO MOORS PRIMARY SCHOOL YEAR 5 INFORMATION



Dear Parents/Carers;

We're delighted to welcome you and your child to Year 5. Below is some helpful information about our routines and expectations to ensure everyone gets off to a great start.

The start of the Day

Children are expected to congregate on the Upper Exe playground. The doors will be opened at 8.40am and the children will go to the cloakroom to hang up their coats and bags.

Registration is at 8.55am. If your child arrives after this, they need to go via the office and will be marked as late.

Year 5 Mornings

Having arrived in class on time, the morning session will start with an early morning activity which enables the children to settle down and 'warm up' for the morning lesson.

Mid-morning Fruit/Snack.

Children are NOT provided with fruit at break time in Key Stage 2 however snacks are available from the kitchen for £1.00 a week. These can be purchased through SCOPAY. Alternatively we would encourage you to provide your child with a healthy snack and a bottle of water **only** to keep them hydrated throughout the day as this will improve their concentration and health.

Lunchtime

This will take place from 12.15 to 1.15. Part of the time will be spent eating lunch in Exmoor hall and during the other time the children will be on the playground.

Phones and walking home

Mobile phones or smart watches are not to be used in school, however if your child needs to use a phone for walking to and from school then they will need to take it to their class teacher for safe keeping. Children are still expected to be collected by an adult. If you would like them to walk home by themselves, please notify the office or class teacher.

P.E.

Scheduled PE sessions will be on **Mondays and Fridays** for Year 5. Children should come into school wearing the appropriate P.E kit. This should consist of trainers, a plain white t-shirt and black shorts or jogging bottoms.

Please can clothes be **labelled clearly** as this makes finding and returning lost items so much easier.

Homework

Homework projects will be set every half term. In addition to the project, children are expected to read and continue to practice their multiplication facts and spellings every week. Reading should be recorded in the children's reading diaries. All children are expected to do their

homework each week. There will be homework support for those children who are struggling to complete their work at home independently. Children can also choose to complete their homework during homework club during the school day on a Monday. One homework task needs to be completed each week.

Medication/Holiday/Absence Forms

Please inform the office before 9am if your child is going to be absent. If your child requires prescribed medicines to be administered at school, please complete a green medical form first, which can be found at the office and inform your child's teacher. Please note that we cannot administer non-prescribed medicines.

Certificates

During celebration assemblies on Fridays, children receive certificates from Mr Dutton in recognition of their hard work and progress. If children have received any awards /certificates /medals outside of school and would like to share them with rest of Exmoor or their class they can bring them in.

Clubs

Activities/clubs are available after school and these are detailed in the school clubs timetable available from the office and on the website. An email is sent out each term with a link to book these online.
